



Dear Resident,

Our new recycling program is doing well and council is pleased with the number of households participating. Any new program presents growing pains and it can be confusing to know what and what not to place in the recycling bags. Please take some time to review this notice and to help avoid your recycling bag being tagged and rejected. Mixing a regular garbage item in a recyclable bag will result in the whole bag being rejected at the Robin Hood Bay Recycling Facility. If a bag is rejected, then an extra fee will be charged, which is contrary to why we are recycling (to reduce tippage fees and reduce waste into the landfill).

Typical recycling errors occur when items are placed into recycling bags that are NOT ACCEPTED. Please take some time to review these guidelines and if you have any further questions please do not hesitate to contact the Town Hall: 726-7930 ext. 24. If your recycling bag was tagged and left at the curbside and you require clarification please call and we will be happy to assist you.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES

- ✓ Recycling items must be separated into **two, clear blue bags**: One for containers, one for paper.
- ✓ Only those containers **specifically noted on the container list** are to be recycled. There are many items that are plastic but are not accepted at Robin Hood Bay. If it is **not on the list** please **DO NOT** put it in the bag as **it will cause your bag to be rejected**.
- ✓ Paper towels, toilet paper, Tim Horton's cups and any dirty, soiled or food contaminated paper products are **NOT** accepted. Please put these in your regular garbage.
- ✓ All cardboard and paper products **must be bagged**.
- ✓ **SCRAP METALS and GLASS are NOT accepted at the curbside**.
- ✓ **PLASTIC BAGS, GROCERY BAGS are NOT accepted** -place in regular garbage
- ✓ **STYROFOAM is NOT accepted** -place in regular garbage

WHAT GOES IN

Bag 1: Paper Products

Newspaper and flyers
Magazines and catalogues
Glossy paper and junk mail
Computer paper, Post-it notes
Soft Cover Books, phone books
Envelopes
Paper towel rolls (inner tube)
Egg cartons: cardboard only (NOT Styrofoam)
Cardboard drink trays
Paper bags
Shoe boxes
Corrugated cardboard boxes -flattened
Hard Cover Books with covers removed

Bag 2: Containers

Aluminum pop and beer cans
Aluminum pie plates/trays/foil (clean)
Soup cans, coffee cans, beans, tuna, etc.
Plastic water bottles, plastic pop bottles
Plastic ketchup, mustard and BBQ
Plastic detergent, bleach, cleaners
Plastic shampoo, body wash, mouth wash
Plastic pill bottles, cough syrup, vitamins
Plastic tubs: butter, sour cream, ice cream
Plastic yogurt and juice containers
Plastic flower pots
Plastic #'s: 1-7
Milk and juice containers, tetra packs

WHAT STAYS OUT

Bubble envelopes
Ribbon, gift wrap/bags
Toilet paper, napkins, paper towels
Pet food bags, take-out food bags/paper
Take-out drink and coffee cups
Diapers
Dirty or food contaminated paper products

Glass bottles and glass jars
Styrofoam
Toys (plastic, wood or metal)
Plastic bags, plastic food wrap
Propane tanks, paint cans, aerosol cans
Diapers and kitty litter
CD cases
