

Recreation Registration & Attendance Priority Policy

This Recreation Registration and Attendance Priority Policy is to establish guidelines and requirements with respect to the Town's recreation programs and events and to outline information regarding priority given during registration and attendance at Town events and programming. Pursuant to the general powers conferred to the Town under the Municipalities Act, 1999, the following regulations were approved and adopted at a regular meeting of Council on , 2022.

Background

The Town organizes and implements recreation programming and events to provide opportunities for residents, groups, and the public to engage in physical activity, community get togethers, fundraisers, tournaments, and other programming as needed. When recreation facilities are in use for Town events or programs, the Town's indoor facility (Justina Centre) is limited to a fire regulation capacity. Town events and programming registration and attendance priority will be determined by capacity numbers. In the case that capacity will be determined an issue the Town will follow the registration and priority attendance list which is listed below. The Town will determine dates, times and order of registration at its discretion.

Definitions

Resident

A member of the Town of Logy Bay-Middle Cove-Outer Cove who lives and resides within the Town's boundaries. They have a civic address (and live primarily at that address) within the Town.

Taxpayer

A member of the public who owns property within the Town boundaries and contributes to the Towns annual taxes. Examples may include: vacant land, rental property, etc.

St. Francis of Assisi School

A member of the St. Francis of Assisi School Community. These children attend St. Francis of Assisi School due to zoning within the Newfoundland and Labrador School District, but do not reside in the Town.

Children of Town Employees

A member of a Town Employee who would not be considered a resident, taxpayer or member of the St. Francis of Assisi school community.

General Public

A member of any community.

Registration & Attendance will be prioritized in the following order (with discretion from Council):

- Town Residents;
- Taxpayers;
- St. Francis of Assisi School;
- Children of Town Employee;
- General Public;

Adoption

Under section 413 of the Municipalities Act, the Town Council of Logy Bay-Middle Cove-Outer Cove adopts the Town of Logy Bay-Middle Cove-Outer Cove Recreation Registration & Attendance Priority Policy as approved. This policy should be reviewed annually, or whenever deemed necessary, by the Town Clerk/Manager and the Recreation & Community Events Committee.
