

FIRE SERVICES RESPONSE STATISTICS

DID YOU KNOW...

The Town is currently paying a base fee of \$375,677.00 for fire and emergency services from the St. John's Regional Fire Department. Each emergency call costs the Town an additional fee. So far, in 2024 additional calls have totaled \$46,689.32.

The stand-by allocation is based upon an assessment of three quarter (3/4) cent per \$10 Property Assessment Value. Three quarter (3/4) cent per \$10 of the current 2024 Property Assessment Value of \$499,835,752 for the Town of Logy Bay-Middle Cove-Outer Cove is \$374,876.81.
